From recycling to upcycling

The international volunteer camp is designed for the participants to work together and to create objects with supports from professional artists. These objects have artistic applied values. During the twelve days of workshop, discarded industrial boilers and other stainless steel waste were upcycled and transformed into garbage bins. Each bin includes a dragon designed by the participants based on their origin and culture. The garbage bins are designed to contribute to sustainable environment on river banks of the Danube river.
